

**The Siddington Village Show 2022
The Village Hall**

**Sunday 4th September
Entries 10-11am: Show 2-4pm**

Cookery Classes – Recipes:

Please do not add any additional ingredients as this may invalidate your entry.

Victoria Sponge Cake:

200g caster sugar, 200g self-raising Flour, 200g softened butter, 4 eggs, 1 tsp vanilla extract.

For the filling: 250ml double cream (whipped), 150g strawberry jam, icing sugar to dust.

Preheat the oven to 190C/170C Fan/Gas Mark 5. Grease and flour two 20cm sandwich tins.

Mix the butter, caster sugar and vanilla extract into a creamy consistency. Slowly beat in the 4 eggs one by one, then fold in the self-raising flour and gently mix until all the flour is used. Divide the mixture between the two tins and bake for about 20 mins until golden brown.

Once cooled, spread the jam onto one cake and top with the whipped cream, then sandwich together and dust with icing sugar. You will only need to enter one slice of cake.

Orange Shortbread Fingers:

125g softened butter, 55g caster sugar, 180g Plain flour, the zest of one orange.

Preheat the oven to 190C/170C fan, Gas mark 5.

Mix the butter, orange zest and sugar until smooth, stir in the flour until you get a smooth paste. Roll out until 1cm thick. Cut the fingers and chill in the fridge for 20 mins.

Bake for 15 – 20 mins until golden brown. You will only need to enter 3 fingers.

The Show is open to all residents of the Siddington Parish. Please make your entries using this form. One form per person making entries, additional forms can be collected from the Siddington Post Office.

Please circle the classes that you are entering, complete your name and address details, hand the completed entry forms to the Siddington Post Office in a **sealed envelope** along with the relevant entry fee by 6pm Friday 2nd September.

Entries are still only 50p per category.

There will be prizes for each winner and certificates for the best 3 in each class and the usual trophies to be awarded too!

Outline recipes for two of the cookery classes are included on the back of this form. Please do not add any additional ingredients as this may invalidate your entry. Where no specific recipe is given be free to use your creativity.

All entries must be grown / made by the entrant **within the last 12 months.**

Entries must be put in place in the village hall between 10:00am and 11:00am on the morning of the event and judging will take place from 11:30 during which time the hall will be closed to all visitors.

Exhibits must be left in situ until the end of the show.

At 2:00pm we will open the doors to visitors and the show will commence. You can view the entries and see who has won! There will be the usual raffle with great prizes as well as the Produce and Plant stall selling fruit and veg grown here in the village.

At 3:30pm the raffle will be drawn and prizes will be available for collection and the trophies will be awarded.
